
NIE - Practice Exam

Grading

By default, students will be able to view the practice exam content, but they won't be able to see if they've gotten the practice questions right or wrong. You can enable this feature by making a few small changes to an activity's settings.

In the example below, I've selected the "Reading" activity, and then I've turned on the "Assign to Class" switch. Next, I've made sure the start and end dates are set correctly, and then I've turned on the 'Grade Automatically" feature:
